

About SSC CGL

Staff Selection Commission, Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT) Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions is an organization under Government of India to recruit staff for various posts in the various Ministries and Departments of the Government of India and in Subordinate Offices. SSC (Staff Selection Commission) holds the CGL (Combined Graduate Level) Exam for the appointment of aspirants in 30 posts in Grade B and C category under different departments of various government ministries, offices and departments. Combined Graduate Level Jobs is an important part of the Functioning Government of India and in Subordinate Offices.

Its headquarters is located in New Delhi and it is attached with DoPT (Department of Personnel and Training). SSC recruits candidates through seven such exams including SSC CGL, SSC CHSL, SSC JE, SSC SI ASI, SSC JHT, etc. The selected aspirants are appointed under Grade-'B' & 'C' scale. SSC is the second most popular institution after UPSC and largest body to staff such number of candidates under government jobs.

Every year approx. 30 - 40 Lakhs eligible candidates apply for the Staff Selection Commission SSC Exam and around 15 - 20 Lakhs candidates appear in the Combined Graduate Level Exam.

SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Application Fee:

The candidates will have to pay Rs. 100/- as application fee. However, no fee is needed to be paid by SC, ST, Female, Physically Handicapped (PH), and Ex-Servicemen (EXS) applicants. SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Application fee should be paid via SBI either in the form of challan or through SBI Net Banking or any other bank Debit/Credit Card.

SSC CGL Tier-I Exam Pattern - Computer Based Examination

The CGL Tier-I exam is an objective type exam which will be held via online mode. Total four sections available is the Tier-I exam with 100 questions which comprising of 200 marks. The details are as below;

SSC CGL Tier-II Exam Pattern - Computer Based Examination

The Tier-II exam is an objective type examination which will be held via online mode. Total four sections available in the Tier 2 exam with 100 questions which comprising of 200 marks. The details are as below;

* Paper-1 & 2 are compulsory for all posts and Paper-3 is only for the "Statistical Investigator Gr. II" & "Compiler" Post. In addition to the Paper-4 is only the "Assistant Audit Officer" Post.

* Negative Marking is applicable of 0.50 Marks for Paper I, III, IV and 0.25 marks for Paper-II.

* Questions in Paper-I will be of 10th level, Paper-2 of 10+2 level, and Paper-3 & 4 will be of graduation level.

* The exam duration is 2 Hours and 40 Minutes for candidates who are visually handicapped.

SSC CGL Tier-III Exam Pattern - Pen and Paper Mode (Descriptive paper)

The Tier 3 exam would be an offline, written exam of descriptive type paper. This exam will be of 60 minute duration and carry 100 marks. The Paper would comprise writing of a Passage of 250 words / Essay and Application /Letter Writing of approx 150 words. However, for qualifying in the Tier-III exam, candidates has to secure 33% marks.

SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Syllabus:

General Intelligence & Reasoning: This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding, statement conclusion, syllogistic reasoning etc. The topics are, Semantic Analogy, Symbolic/Number Analogy, Figural Analogy, Semantic Classification, Symbolic/Number Classification, Figural Classification, Semantic Series, Number Series, Figural Series, Problem Solving, Word Building, Coding & de-coding, Numerical Operations, symbolic Operations, Trends, Space Orientation, Space Visualization, Venn Diagrams, Drawing inferences, Punched hole/pattern –folding & unfolding, Figural Pattern – folding and completion, Indexing, Address matching, Date & city matching, Classification of centre codes/roll numbers, Small & Capital letters/numbers coding, decoding and classification, Embedded Figures, Critical thinking, Emotional Intelligence, Social Intelligence, Other sub-topics, if any.

General Awareness: Questions in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated

person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy & Scientific Research.

Quantitative Aptitude: The questions will be designed to test the ability of appropriate use of numbers and number sense of the candidate. The scope of the test will be the computation of whole numbers, decimals, fractions and relationships between numbers, Percentage. Ratio & Proportion, Square roots, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Partnership Business, Alligation and Mixture, Time, Speed and distance (River, Boat, Train), Time & Work, Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra & Elementary surds, Graphs of Linear Equations, Triangle and its various kinds of centres, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle and its chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, common tangents to two or more circles, Triangle, Quadrilaterals, Regular Polygons, Circle, Right Prism, Right Circular Cone, Right Circular Cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular Parallelepiped, Regular Right Pyramid with triangular or square base, Trigonometric ratio, Degree and Radian Measures, Standard Identities, Complementary angles, Heights and Distances, Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar diagram & Pie chart.

English Comprehension: Candidates' ability to understand correct English, his basic comprehension, and writing ability, etc. would be tested. The questions in Parts A, B, & D will be of a level commensurate with the essential qualification viz. Graduation and questions in Part C will be of 10th standard level.

SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Selection Process:

SSC CGL Selection Process 2019 includes 4 tiers steps,

- **Tier-1 Exam:** Computer Based Examination (Objective Type) (200 Marks)
- **Tier-2 Exam:** Computer Based Examination (Objective Type) (each paper carry 200 marks)
- **Tier-3 Exam:** Pen and Paper Mode (Descriptive Type) (100 Marks)
- **Tier-4 Exam:** Computer Proficiency Test/ Skill Test (wherever applicable)/ Document Verification

1.SSC CGL Admit Card 2019:

SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Application Form, those candidates who will successfully submit it, will be able to download SSC CGL Admit Card 2019 for Tier-I exam from 2nd week of July because SSC CGL Tier-I exam is expected to be held from last week of July 2019 for all regions. The **SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Admit Card** will be released region wise on the official website of SSC CGL. First of all, the commission will release the application status and after that SSC CGL Tier-I Admit Card 2019. Candidates will be able to download their call letter by using their registration number and date of birth which they have used in the application form submission.

2.SSC CGL Cut Off 2019:

The SSC CGL Cut-Off marks are the minimum marks which are required to qualify the Combined Graduate Level exam. The SSC CGL EXAM 2019 cut-off marks will be released with the result declaration. The **SSC CGL Cut-off 2019** for Tier I Exam will be dependent on the section wise difficulty level of the paper and number of students who appeared for the exam.

3.SSC CGL Result 2019:

SSC CGL Tier-I Result 2019 is expected to be announced after 2 months of examination. Candidates who will appear in the tier-I exam and will be successfully attempted the examination, will be able to check their result from the official website. This year CGL Tier-I exam is expected to be held from July 2019. **SSC CGL Result 2019** will be released on the official website with cut off marks and candidates will be able to check their result by using their roll number and name. Only those candidates will be able to appear in Tier-II examination who will clear the CGL Tier-I 2018 Exam successfully.

4.SSC CGL EXAM 2019 Online Test Series:

SSC CGL Online Test Series 2019 is provided for thorough practice with many mock test and separate sectional tests to help candidates improve their skills. These tests will
